Prescription Monitoring Program System Security

The new PMP system will go-live on **July 28, 2016** and has a significantly enhanced security and user management system. This change requires that everyone re-register. We understand that our current users will be inconvenienced, so we have made every effort to make registration go smoothly and quickly. Registration will open on **June 27, 2016**.

The following are system security requirements/rules that registered PMP system users should note:

1. Passwords will expire every 90 days.
2. Password rules will be enforced.
3. Account audits are required every 180 days.
4. Accounts inactive for more than 60 days will be automatically disabled.
5. Inactive accounts can only be reinstated by the primary account holder or a PMP system administrator.
6. Account sharing will not be allowed.
7. Delegates must apply for individual access and must be approved by the primary account holder.
8. Delegates who leave employment should be disabled immediately by the primary account holder.
9. Federal applications must include the supervisor's name and phone number or the name and phone number of the credentialing authority for employment verification.
10. PMP access and the use of PMP reports will be routinely monitored.
11. PMP reports may not be used for employment screening or other non-patient related activities.
12. Delegates must sign onto the system with their username and by identifying the primary PMP account holder for whom they are running reports.
13. Primary account holders are responsible for all delegates. Primary account holders are allowed to review the activity of their delegates.
14. Law enforcement account holders cannot use the PMP system to randomly check PMP reports. All PMP report requests must be pursuant to an active investigation.
